City of New Castle	High-grade office paper, office paper, aluminum, leaves, steel & bi-metal cans, all color glass, #1 PETE, and #2 HDPE	Written warning first and second offenses, \$100-\$1,000 after that
Borough of Ellwood City	High-grade office paper, office paper, office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, leaves, steel & bi-metal cans, all color glass, #1 PETE, and #2 HDPE, newspaper, and magazines	\$100-\$300
Neshannock Township	High-grade office paper, office paper, office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, leaves, steel & bi-metal cans, all color glass, #1 PETE, and #2 HDPE, and newspaper	\$100-\$300
Borough of New Wilmington	High-grade office paper, office paper, office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, leaves, steel & bi-metal cans, all color glass, #1 PETE, and #2 HDPE, newspaper, and magazines	Up to \$100
Shanango Township	High-grade office paper, office paper, office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, leaves – these are the minimum requirements of the State. Call 724-658-4460 for more information.	\$300-\$1,000; Imprisonment of 10-30 days results in default of paying fine
Union Township	High-grade office paper, office paper, office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, leaves, steel & bi-metal cans, all color glass, #1 PETE, and #2 HDPE	\$100-\$300
